## 1. The Promoter

Chapter 1 The promoter is: ONTIC ENGINEERING & MANUFACTURING UK LIMITED

## 2. The competition

2.1 The title of the competition is Lions at Large

## 3. How to enter

3.1 The competition will run from 00:00 on [11/07/2025] (the "**Opening Date**") to 23:59 on 14/09/2025 (the "**Closing Date**") inclusive.

3.2 All competition entries must be received by the Promoter by no later than 23:59 on the Closing Date. All competition entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.

3.3 To enter the competition:

- (a) Enter the competition online by scanning the QR code displayed on the 'The Tyger' sculpture located on the Lions walking trail using a suitable electronic device. You will be required to download the Lions at Large App once you have scanned the QR code. Once the QR code is scanned you will be taken to the Lions at Large App and then directed to the Promoter's website where you will be required to provide your details via an email to [lionscompetition@ontic.com](mailto:lionscompetition@ontic.com). This must be completed before 23.59 on the 14<sup>th</sup> of September 2025.

3.4 No purchase necessary and there is no charge to register for use of the website.

3.5 The Promoter will **not** accept:

- (a) responsibility for competition entries that are corrupted, not successfully completed or transmitted, lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal

failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, website, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or

- (b) proof of posting or transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the competition.

3.6 By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

#### **4. Eligibility**

4.1 The competition is only open to all residents in the UK aged 18 years or over, **except:**

- (a) the employees of, or those of, any holding or subsidiary companies;
- (b) the employees of agents or suppliers or those of, or its holding or subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with the competition or its administration; or
- (c) members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above

of either the Promoter or Lion at Large (Registered Charity Number 1051606).

4.2 In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the competition.

4.3 The Promoter will not accept competition entries that are:

- (a) automatically generated by computer or created by artificial intelligence (including but not limited to chatbots such as ChatGPT or similar software applications);

- (b) completed by third parties or in bulk;
- (c) illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with;
- (d) photocopies and not originals; or
- (e) incomplete.

4.4 There is a limit of one entry per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted, and joint submissions are not allowed.

4.5 The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.

4.6 Competition entries cannot be returned.

## **5. The prize**

5.1 The prize is a £1,000 TUI holiday voucher and one voucher is available to be won. The voucher will be subject to TUI's own Terms and Conditions (<https://www.tui.co.uk/destinations/info/booking-terms-and-conditions> )

5.2 The holiday voucher is provided by the Promoter.

5.3 There is no cash alternative for the prize

5.4 The Promoter reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the Promoter's control makes it necessary to do so.

5.5 The prize is not negotiable.

5.6 In order to claim the prize you must respond to the Promoter's email or telephone call within 14 days of them contacting you, using the details that will be provided in the email and/or telephone message that is left by the Promoter.

## **6. Winners**

6.1 The decision of the Promoter is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

6.2 The Promoter will contact the winner personally on or after the Draw Date, using the telephone number and/or email address provided with the competition entry. The Promoter will not amend any contact information once the competition entry form has been submitted.

- 6.3 The Promoter must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the Promoter will publish the surname and county of major prize winners on the Ontic website [www.ontic.com] on [21/09/2025] (Announcement Date).
- 6.4 If you object to any or all of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available, please contact the Promoter [Lionscompetition@ontic.com]. In such circumstances, the Promoter must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

## **7. Claiming the prize**

If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available or has not claimed their prize within 14 of days of the Promoter notifying you that you are a winner, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date.
- 7.4 The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.

## **8. Limitation of liability**

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

- 10.3 This competition is in no way sponsored endorsed administered by or associated with TUI.
- 10.4 These terms and conditions are governed by English law. If any entrants to this promotion wish to take court proceedings, then they must do this within the courts in the United Kingdom.
